Programming Update

In Programming, we have several seniors and two underclassman who are being trained up to lead the way next year.



They started by dividing into task forces and creating reusable code for future use. Now that the competition robot is mostly completed, the robot is being tested.



The code has been tweaked and retuned, and we've gathered feedback from the drivers on possible enhancements. We are close to completion, but there is always room for improvement.



In the Build area, we began at the beginning of the season by building a prototype of the robot to determine the best design for various aspects of the robot. Now over the past 2 months the competition robot has been constructed. There are only a few last minute details we are working on. Some of the design struggles we've had to overcome are that there are many parts that need to fit together in a way that doesn't interfere with the conveyor or a movable arm.

We previously built a practice game floor for various elements to allow the drive team to practice driving the robot. Since we are so close to our first competition we have been putting extra effort into getting our drivers on the field practicing.
